Install JSR

How to install JavaScript Restrictor from source?

- 1. Go to the project repository https://github.com/polcak/jsrestrictor
- 2. Download the desired branch, e.g. as zip
- 3. Unpack the zip file
- 4. Run make
 - We currently support GNU/Linux and Apple Mac OS, we plan to Support Windows
 - You will need common software, such as wget, bash, awk, sed
- 5. Import the extension to the browser
 - Firefox: https://extensionworkshop.com/documentation/develop/temporary-installation-in-firefox/
 - Use the file firefox_JSR.zip created by make
 - Chromium-based browsers:
 - 1. Open chrome://extensions
 - 2. Enable developper mode
 - 3. Click Load unpacked
 - 4. Import the chrome_JSR/ directory created by make
